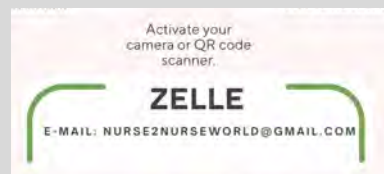

Our Humble beginnings.....

Nurse2Nurse a non-profit organization was started approximately 6 years ago by Kolu Mator.

It all started when York Hospital changed their Uniform code. Kolu asked if the hospital if they would be interested in donating for the “sparingly used old scrubs” which would be donated to other health care employees in her native country of Liberia who are less privileged than those in the U.S. Liberia is a country in West Africa that had endured three civil wars over 16 years

The “Scrub” Drive

The “Scrub” drive was a great success. Kolu and her family were able to donate over **7000 sets of scrubs to 14 health care facilities** with the Samaritan Purse Organization providing the much needed transportation. While distributing the scrubs, Kolu assessed the devastation that years of war had on the health Care system, especially the plight of the nurses. It was during this time

she was inspired to form a non-profit organization which would benefit many of the less fortunate health care employees all over the world; but beginning with those in Liberia.

Nurse2Nurse is Born....

In March of 2020, a five member assessment Team of Nurses2Nurse volunteers travelled to Liberia and met with the leadership of the Ministry of Health of Liberia. During that meeting they discussed the goals and focus of the organization. It was determined that Nurse2nurse focus on **providing basic essentials for nurses and enhance their training.**

Nurse2Nurse Fundraising

To date our major means of fundraising has been by donations and by holding extravagant annual Galas. This year, having had 6 very successful Galas, we are working on our 7th Annual Gala. Our goal of training and equipping 1,000 Liberian nurses and midwives with nursing assessment kits was achieved in March, 2025. These kits consist of blood pressure cuffs, thermometers, an oxygen saturation probe, CPR masks, and AAA batteries. Each kits costs approximately \$80/

Nurse2Nurse Training....

To measure the effectiveness of the training, a pre-test and a post test are administered to the nurses. The pre-test scores average around 20% with the post test scores averaging 89%.
